Three Ministries

Two Messages

WORD AND SPIRIT MINISTRIES/MICAIAH. MICAIAH's **two sites**, and various peripherals, such as **BLOG**, and **VIDEOS**, are devoted to the ideal of developing and maintaining a total Spiritual maturity in the believer. Typically, the various groups that assemble to worship, minister, fellowship, and simply to fulfill the Divine mandate of Heb. 10:25, take on the characteristics of one of two types. The one type typically concentrates on that, "mystical," Spiritual side of the Christian walk, and de-emphasizes, or relatively forgets or neglects the Word of God: their walk is primarily subjective, with little of the "black-and-white" objectivity of the Word of God, or the resulting holiness of personal character. Holiness appears to them to be legalism. The other group concentrates on the Word of God and holiness, and, in comparison, de-emphasizes, or almost forgets or neglects the supernatural, "mystical," element of the Christian walk, that which might be called their actual relationship with the Person of God Who Is the Word. In them, holiness can actually become legalism.

WORD AND SPIRIT MINISTRIES is devoted to the pursuit of the proper measure of both: that is why we put the Bible and the dove (the Holy Spirit), into the **MINISTRY's** logo. And the cross represents the holiness of Christ in us.

THE FINAL OBJECT OF THIS DUAL GOAL is the development of a complete maturity in the Christian. It is the job of any pastor to, in effect, work himself out of his job: to encourage and facilitate the development of a complete Spiritual maturity in the lives of every one of those in his congregation, and to see that not only the individual Christian, but also the local church body, is able to continue, if need be, quite well without him! It is the will of God, and thus the pastor's mandate, that each individual in the church body be brought to a point of relative, "self-sufficiency," in the body of Christ: that he be able, and wish, to research and study the Word of God on his own, and that he develop a real holiness through an intimate relationship with God Himself, with his Saviour Jesus Christ, and with the Holy Spirit. That he work in the Spiritual gifts for the glorification of God, and the edification of God's people. He will show the Person of God through his life, to both (first) his fellow Christian and (then) to those outside the Body of Christ. He will understand his natural talents and his Spiritual gifts, and he will have been encouraged and helped to develop these gifts in his own life and in the context of the body of believers. He will thus be more of a 'giver' than a 'taker' and be enabled (by means of his natural talents from God, and by the gifts that God will have given Him by the Infilling of the Holy Spirit) to carry the Gospel of the Kingdom to not only others in the local church, but also to the local community, and to the uttermost ends of the world. This maturity, while necessary now, will prove absolutely essential to every believer during the fast-approaching great tribulation. But, most importantly, God will be glorified to the maximum extent of His people's abilities!

WORD AND SPIRIT MINISTRIES thus emphasizes two very important, and mutually-dependent, elements of the Christian life:

a) THE WORD OF GOD and HOLINESS.

EVERYTHING IN THE BIBLE is applicable and important to the Christian walk (excepting, of course, certain applications of the Law in the Old Testament). The Bible Is our Guidebook at all times, and in every area of our life, no matter how unfleshly or unnatural it may be to us personally. To portray the Character of God in our life is the most important task of the Christian, as it is the most glorifying to God of anything we could ever allow God to do through us. Studying and teaching the Word for a knowledge of God and a zeal for holiness is thus emphasized by **WORD AND SPIRIT MINISTRIES**.

b) THE HOLY SPIRIT and SPIRITUALITY.

THE INFILLING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT, as a separate, definite experience after salvation, as shown in the WORD OF GOD, is necessary for every believer. The works of the Holy Spirit are seen, most importantly, in the FRUIT of the Spirit that this works in the believer, and then also in the GIFTS of the Holy Spirit, also through every believer. Both the fruit and the gifts of the Spirit are intended by God to be, first, for the glorification of Him, and then for the edification of His people and then of the unsaved. Welcoming the Holy Spirit, receiving His infilling, exercising His gifts, and pursuing a personal walk with God through prayer is thus a second strong emphasis of this Ministry.
